

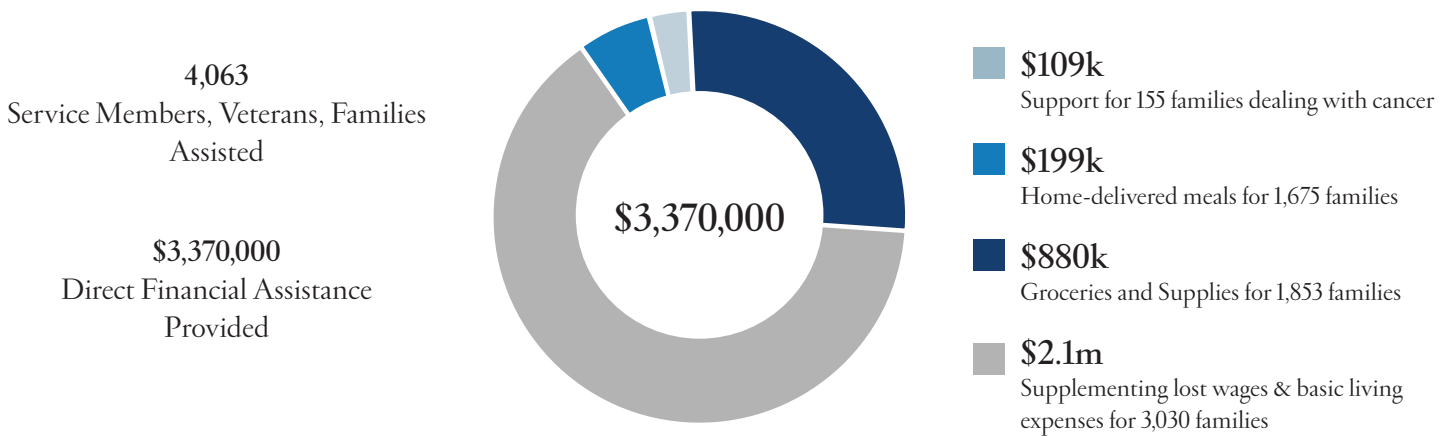


COVID-19: Positioned to Support and Equipped to Act
